1) What are the fruits and vegetables you wish to handle – name each of them	<p>Vegetables: Brinjal, Potato, Cauliflower, Cabbage, Lady Finger, Beans, Gourds Green Chillies</p> <p>Fruits: Mangoes, Papaya, Pomegranate, Tomatoes.</p>
2) Input capacity required for each fruit and vegetable you intend to handle on per hour basis	<p>The aggregate input capacity considered is 1 MT for any/all fruits and vegetables. No capacity for each variety is considered separately. Fruits and vegetable being seasonal in nature, the quantum to be processed is determined by their availability and market outlook for the same at any given point.</p>
3) How you will get/receive fruits and vegetables in pack houses i.e., whether loose or in crates pl. specify	<p>Majority of the vegetables and fruits will be received in plastic crates of 15 – 20 kgs capacity.</p> <p>Cauliflower and Cabbage may be received in gunny bags</p>
4) Do you want washing, dry cleaning, inspection/sorting of each fruit and vegetable pl. specify	<p>Visual inspection and sorting on a moving conveyor; Washing, sponging and drying by hot air of all the produce being handled is considered</p>
<p>5) Do you need fruit and vegetables to be graded if yes pl. specify: Whether you need grading by size or by weight or by colour or all pl. specify. How many grades in each case pl. specify.</p>	<p>After washing and drying, certain fruits and vegetables except cabbage and cauliflower (as mango, tomato, potato and brinjal) will be mechanically graded, as per size, with the help of inclined conveyor. Where product size heterogeneity is high, grading will be carried out manually.</p>
6) What type of packing of sorted and graded fruits and vegetables you wish to go for i.e., packing crates/packing in carton/packing in net bags/packing in poly bags or no packing.	<p>All the processed and graded produce will be distributed in perforated plastic crates of 15 – 20 kg capacity.</p> <p>Only a small quantity of vegetables and fruits will be diced and packed in unit packs up to 1 kg</p>
7) If packing is required pl. specify pack size in each case	<p>All the processed and graded produce will be distributed in perforated plastic crates of 15 – 20 kg capacity.</p> <p>Only a small quantity of vegetables and fruits will be diced and packed in unit packs up to 1 kg</p>
8) PAYMNT TERMS which are not in line with industry norms and needs to be looked into. The general payment terms are: 30% advance	<p>Clause 5.3.1 relating to payment terms is modified as follows: 30% advance along with purchase order/supply agreement against submission of Bank Guarantee (BG) of equivalent amount with validity</p>

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<p>60% against proforma invoice prior to dispatch with all taxes extras 10% against BANK GUARANTEE for 12 months against supply</p> <p>Another suggestion desired the following payment modalities: 40% advance along with purchase order/supply agreement 40% on receipt of plant and machinery/equipment at site 20% on successful commencement of plant and machinery/equipment</p>	<p>until the time of erection & commissioning with an additional claim period of 60 days. BG will be released at the time of release of final payment.</p> <p>20% on receipt of plant and machinery/equipment at site and physical verification of equipment by SPV or its authorized agent.</p> <p>30% on successful commissioning of plant and machinery/equipment and trial runs.</p> <p>20% on training of SPV staff and issuance of completion certificate by client or its appointed consultant.</p>
<p>9) Size of the cold storage building/site earmarked for cold storage</p>	<p>Area earmarked for cold storage 720 Sq. MTs. Accordingly the supplier/bidder has to design the capacity of 900 MT cold storage</p>
<p>10) More clarity on maximum quantum of penalty for non-supply of machinery and equipment within the specified period (5.6.2)</p>	<p>Clause 5.6.2 may be modified as follows: The machinery & equipment must be supplied within the specified time as per supply order, otherwise, 1% deduction per week up to a maximum of four weeks will be done from the cost of instrument. Still the equipment is not supplied; order will be treated as cancelled.</p>
<p>11) Exemption of payment of EMD for SMEs registered with NSIC under its single point registration scheme</p>	<p>All bids must be accompanied by a bid security/Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) to be enclosed with the Technical Bid as specified in the bid document. No exemption of Bid Security will be given for any bidder.</p>
<p>12) Request for extension of time for bid submission: Two weeks from the time of provision of clarifications by SPV</p>	<p>The last date of submission of bids is 9th January 2019 till 17:00 hrs</p>
